Addressing Sponsors or Ads in Podcasts

Potential Discussion Questions

- 1. Who are the sponsors?
- 2. How does the sponsor's business align with the topic of the podcast?
- 3. Was a product or service advertised?
- 4. Is the relationship between the podcaster and the advertiser disclosed and readily available?
- 5. Who products or pays for the podcast? Do they have a financial motive or product to sell?
