Cathy's work is focused on helping Pennsylvania residents address perennial consumer issues such as budgeting, using credit, recordkeeping, consumer rights and responsibilities and teaching kids about money. Cathy oversees a volunteer income tax assistance site (VITA) where law and accounting students serve as volunteers. She teaches a course *Consumer and Financial Skills* that is ideal for students who want to learn how to make key decisions early in life that can secure their financial future. Cathy's work has received national awards by professional organizations as well as been featured on NPR, National Public Radio and CNN's *Open House*.



Cathy is a member of several organizations including The Association for Financial Counseling and Planning Education, The American Association of Family and Consumer Sciences, National Extension Association of Family and Consumer Sciences, and The Financial Planning Association.
